- Optimize within these limits

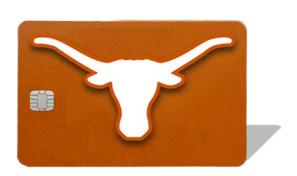


## The Power of Thinking Inside the Box

• Inside the Box Thinking isn't about limiting creativity; it's about maximizing it within the constraints.

Focus on what's possible, not on unrealistic solutions.

Address real-world opportunities efficiently.



## Identifying Diminishing Returns

#### When quality hurts productivity:

- Over-refining processes can degrade morale and slow output.
- Recognizing the point where diminishing returns affect productivity is key to maintaining balance.

**Example**: Spending hours perfecting non-critical tasks leads to lost time and resources.



## **Driving Process Efficiency**



Optimize workflows within the boundaries of your organization.



Eliminate bottlenecks and manual processes that consume unnecessary time and resources.



Utilize technology and automation where possible.



## Leveraging Team Strengths

• Understand your team's core competencies and strengths.

Allocate tasks based on these strengths to maximize efficiency.

 Encourage collaboration to spark innovation within existing processes.



## Generating Rebate Dollars

- Financial Impact: Streamlining processes can lead to rebate opportunities.
- Vendor Management: Ensure that you're maximizing rebate programs with strategic vendor partnerships.
- Case Study: Organizations that have optimized purchasing workflows have seen significant rebate increases:
  - <u>University of Michigan:</u> The university automated workflows for high-volume transactions, allowing them to achieve notable rebate increases through early-payment discounts and vendor partnerships.
  - <u>Texas A&M University System:</u> By centralizing their procurement, they improved spend management and rebate programs with better supplier negotiations and compliance.
  - <u>California Community Colleges:</u> By standardizing purchasing workflows, they maximized rebate programs, saving over \$10 million.
  - <u>Texas State University</u>: Optimized procurement with an automated workflow, increasing rebates and reducing transaction times.

## Innovation Through Process Improvement

**Innovation** is not just about new ideas; it's about improving what already exists.

- Foster a culture of continuous improvement.
- Encourage regular feedback and process adjustments.
- Implement small changes that lead to big results.

**Example**: Eliminate an audit procedure that states "All new accounts will be reviewed for the first 90 days to ensure compliance".
